House Bill 6732 or "An Act Granting the ABS-CBN Corporation A Franchise to Construct, Install, Operate and Maintain Radio and Television Broadcasting Stations in the Philippines, and For Other Purposes" filed by Speaker Alan Peter Cayetano and several other lawmakers

Background/Description of the Disclosure

On May 13, 2020, the House of Representatives Committee of the Whole approved on second reading House Bill 6732 (HB 6732) or "An Act Granting the ABS-CBN Corporation A Franchise to Construct, Install, Operate and Maintain Radio and Television Broadcasting Stations in the Philippines, and For Other Purposes", which bill grants ABS-CBN Corporation a franchise valid until October 31, 2020.

The passage of HB 6732 follows the legislative process on the passage of a law. As the said bill was approved on the second reading, it will be scheduled for a third reading for its approval by the House of Representatives. The approved bill is transmitted to the Senate for its concurrence.

At the Senate, a bill undergoes the same process as that of the House of Representatives. If a bill is approved by the Senate, copies of the bill, signed by the Senate President and Speaker of the House of the Representatives, will be transmitted to the President for his action. If a bill is approved by the President, it generally becomes law after its publication.
