STATEMENT ON KIDZANIA MANILA'S TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF OPERATIONS

KidZania Manila, which provides a learning experience for children ages 4 to 17, has remained closed since March 11, 2020 before the implementation of the enhanced community quarantine as part of its safety measures in preventing the spread of COVID-19.

The play city shall also remain closed following the new declaration of modified enhanced community quarantine in the National Capital Region starting May 16.

With the eventual shift to general community quarantine, KidZania Manila will still not be allowed to open during this period, as current GCQ guidelines issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force still prohibit those in the kids industry from operating; ban entertainment-related mass gatherings; and forbid children to leave their homes.

The successive extensions of the quarantine have adversely affected the company. After serious discernment, Play Innovations Inc., the franchisee of KidZania Manila, has decided to file a temporary suspension of operations with the Department of Labor and Employment effective 16 June to 15 August 2020, to manage and mitigate further losses to the business while exploring new revenue solutions.

While the play city's operations remain suspended, the company commits to assist the employees who will be in furlough by providing them financial assistance and health insurance benefits.
